They have 2 local charity shops

One is located in **Torrevieja** at 41 Calle Patricio Zammit and this shop is open Monday/Wednesday and Friday from 10 am until 2 pm and 5 pm until 7 pm on a Thursday.

The other is located in **Los Montesinos** 39b Avenida del Mar and its opening times are 10am until 2pm Monday to Friday.

Their main centre is located in **La Siesta** in **Calle Paganini** and the centre is open Monday to Friday from 10am to 1.30pm.

The aim of the Torrevieja Stroke Support Group (TSSG) is to enable stroke victims to access help and support.

This can be done in the following ways:

Sharing experience and knowledge

Sharing time together on simple activities and outings.

Rehabilitation and learning to cope with stroke damage and appointments with an Occupational Therapist, Physio and Speech Therapist are always able to be booked.

Recreation and hobbies such as painting, singing, exercise, games, quizzes and crafts all of which are presided over by trained volunteers.

Social activities such as the monthly wheelchair-friendly outing which includes lunch and with occasional respite breaks and coach trips.

This charity is solely reliant upon donations and help from volunteers to continue its fantastic work.

They have a charity shop in **Benjofar** which is located at 45 Calle Del Sol and they welcome donations and shoppers alike.

Their main centre is also located in **Benjofar** at Case De Cultura, Calle Francisco Ribera Pirez 7 and they can be reached by calling 653 588 475.
